

SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to all prospective bidders to clarify, modify and/or amend items in the Bidding Documents as discussed during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 10 January 2022 for the Procurement for the Lease of Multi-Function and Energy-Efficient Network Printers and Copying Machines (Early Procurement Activity) DOT-BAC-IB NO. 2021-021, as follows:

II. The following amendments and clarifications are provided for the prospective bidder(s) guidance and reference:

- 1) Files should be saved in the following formats:
 - a. PDF (Portable Document Format)
 - b. JPG or JPEG (Joint Photographic Experts Group)
 - c. PNG (Portable Network Graphics)
 - d. TIF or TIFF (Tagged Image File Format)
- 2) Complete Delivery and installation should be completed within 45-days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP)

For purposes of determining the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB), the following estimated quantity shall be used by the prospective bidders:

- 1. For Monochrome -
 - 6,500 copies per month
- 2. For Colored -
 - 2,500 copies per month

For purposes of submitting the Price Proposal, the prospective bidder must show the cost per page multiplied to the estimated number of pages per month, then multiply to twelve (12) months, to show the total bid price. The same must not exceed the ABC.

All unamended portions of the Bidding Documents shall remain the same.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents.

Please be informed that the <u>deadline of submission</u> and <u>opening of bids</u> have been moved to <u>January 26, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.</u>, respectively.
