I. PROJECT TITLE : Taiwan Familiarization Tour in Clark, Subic, and Baguio

II. DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION: 20 to 27 January 2019

III. NUMBER OF PAX: 16 (12 Taiwanese Agents, 2 OPMD-ESL Staff, 1 DOT

Region III staff for Region III leg, 1 DOT CAR staff for Baguio leg, and 1 Chinese-speaking Tour Guide)

IV. DESTINATIONS: Clark, Subic, and Baguio

V. BACKGROUND:

To sustain the growing popularity of the Philippines in Taiwan as a study English destination, the OPMD-ESL and eight English academies from Cebu, Baguio and Clark participated in the Taiwan Summer Travel Fair (TSTF) on July 20 to 23, 2018. The expo which generated approximately 500,000 visitors created opportunities for the schools to showcase their programs and offerings. They were able to provide the market with more information about the Philippines as a study English and tourism destination. The four-day event generated 788 inquiries, 105 closed transactions and partnerships with 18 education agents.

VI. PURPOSE/OBJECTIVES:

The conduct of the familiarization tour is timely and necessary since the Taiwanese agents are looking for other destinations to offer to their clients aside from Cebu which remains to be the most popular choice among foreign students. The Taiwanese agents are having difficulty in sending their students to Cebu from June to August since most of the schools are fully-booked. To address the problem, the OPMD-ESL will showcase the alternative study destinations offering quality programs and fun components to discourage the agents from sending the students to other countries during the period mentioned.
