KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That this Agreement, made and entered into this FEB 2 3 2022 in the City of Makati, Philippines, by and between

The **DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM (DOT)**, a government agency with principal office address at the New DOT Building, 351 Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue, Makati City, Philippines 1200 represented by OIC-Undersecretary for Tourism Regulation, Coordination, and Resource Generation, **ENGR. CHRISTOPHER V. MORALES**, of legal age, Filipino, hereinafter referred to as the "FIRST PARTY";

and

F-STUFF IMAGE OPC is a private entity existing and duly registered under the laws of the Philippines, with office address at 1934 UP Bliss, University Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City and represented by its President, MR. PRABHATANAND REYES, and hereinafter referred to as the "SECOND PARTY":

Each a Party, collectively, the "PARTIES."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is the primary planning, programming, coordinating, implementing and regulatory government agency in the development and promotion of the tourism industry, both domestic and international;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY, through the Office of Industry Manpower Development (OIMD), is also mandated to develop training modules and conduct multi-skills training seminars, including continuing education programs for the industry manpower, in coordination with appropriate government agencies and tourism enterprises and associations, thereby upgrading their quality, competence and excellence in the delivery of tourism services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to its mandates, the FIRST PARTY will produce an Audio Visual Presentation (AVP) to showcase the continuous efforts of the Department both at the central and regional offices in upgrading human resources capability to be globally competitive;

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is in need of a company that provides professional and technical services for the production of the AVP;

WHEREAS, the requirement was processed in compliance with the procedure on Negotiated Procurement-Small Value Procurement, pursuant to Section 53.9 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (Government Procurement Reform Act);

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY, registered under the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and possesses the necessary equipment, personnel, and expertise in providing the required services, has offered to undertake the project;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) of the FIRST PARTY, through BAC Resolution No. 2022-017 has declared the SECOND PARTY to be the bidder with the Single Rated and Responsive Bid (SRRB) as its quotation is found to be compliant and responsive to the technical specifications indicated in the Terms of Reference (TOR);

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the PARTIES hereby agree as follows:

- 1. SERVICES. The SECOND PARTY hereby agrees to provide the following:
 - Engage a team of technical personnel required for the production of the AVP;
 - Conceptualization and development of the script of the AVP aligned with the DOT training policies and thrusts;
 - c. Produce one mother AVP with two versions of 7 minutes each and one 3-minute version, which will feature the program thrusts and accomplishments of the OIMD and "subjects" Filipino tourism professionals, front liners, tourism enterprises, organizations and communities in the tourism industry:
 - d. Post-production process and submission of the AVP in high definition.

Details of the above including the other duties and responsibilities of the **SECOND PARTY** are indicated in the attached **Terms of Reference**, which forms an integral part of this contract.

- EFFECTIVITY AND TERM. This Agreement shall be effective from the date of issuance of Notice of Award until 30 June 2022.
- COMPENSATION. By way of compensation for its services, the FIRST PARTY shall pay the SECOND PARTY the total amount indicated in the Statement of Account, but not to exceed Six Hundred Fifteen Thousand Pesos (PhP615,000.00) for the total actual cost of services rendered inclusive of VAT and other taxes.
- 4. PAYMENT. The above consideration will be paid by the FIRST PARTY after presentation of the required Statement of Account and other necessary documents, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations by the SECOND PARTY. It is understood, however, that payment shall only be made after it has fully and satisfactorily rendered its undertaking under this agreement.
- 5. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES. If the SECOND PARTY fails to deliver any or all of the Services within the period(s) specified under this Agreement, the FIRST PARTY shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under this Agreement and under the Applicable Law, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the price of the unperformed portion of the Services for each day of delay based on the approved contract schedule. The FIRST PARTY need not prove that it has incurred actual damages to be entitled to liquidated damages. Once the amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the total contract price, the FIRST PARTY may consider termination of this Agreement.
- 6. FREE AND HARMLESS. The SECOND PARTY shall hold the FIRST PARTY free and harmless from, and hereby binds and obligates itself to indemnify the FIRST PARTY for any and all liabilities, losses, damages, injuries, including death, claims, demands, suits, proceeding, judgments, awards, fines, penalties and all expenses, legal or otherwise of whatever kind or nature arising from and by reason of this Agreement, due to the fault, negligence, act, act omission, delays, conduct, breach of trust, or non-observance or violation of this Agreement, or any of its stipulation and warranties by the SECOND PARTY and/or any of its employees, agents, representatives, or sub-contractors.
- 7. OWNERSHIP OF MATERIALS. Any videos, photos, or other materials, graphic software or otherwise, prepared by the SECOND PARTY for the FIRST PARTY under this Agreement shall belong to and remain property of the FIRST PARTY. The SECOND PARTY may retain a copy of such documents and software, exclusively for record purposes and the same shall not be published, reproduced, or distributed without the written consent of the FIRST PARTY.
- 8. DISPUTE RESOLUTION. If any dispute shall arise between the FIRST PARTY and the SECOND PARTY in connection with this Agreement, the Parties shall make every effort to

resolve such dispute amicably. Should such dispute not be resolved, the same will be referred for arbitration in accordance with RA No. 876 or the Arbitration Law and RA No. 9285 or the Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004.

- 9. ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES. The parties shall be entitled to sign and transmit this Agreement with an electronic signature whether by facsimile, e-mail, or other electronic means, which signature shall be binding on the Party whose name is contained therein. Any Party providing an electronic signature agrees to promptly execute and deliver to the other parties an original signed Agreement upon request.
- 10. COMPLETENESS OF AGREEMENT. This Agreement, along with the select provisions in the annexes made integral parts hereof, contains the complete understanding of the Parties and may not be modified or amended except through another Agreement in writing duly executed by the parties.
