This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to all prospective bidders to clarify, modify and/or amend items in the Bidding Documents as discussed and agreed during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 15 October 2021 for the Procurement of Service Provider for the Conduct of On-Site Anti-Flu and Anti-Pneumococcal Vaccination Program for DOT Officials and Employees (Permanent and Job-Order Personnel) (2nd Posting) (DOT-BAC IB 2021-009), as follows:

III. The following amendments and clarifications are provided for the prospective bidder(s) guidance and reference:

- 1) Bidders must have a certification from DENR authorizing the company to properly dispose used syringes, to be checked during post-qualification.
- 2) Anti-influenza and anti-pneumococcal vaccines may be administered simultaneously.
- 3) Projects with similar nature refers to supply, delivery, and administration of vaccines and may refer either to the administration of anti-flu or anti-pneumococcal vaccines.
- 4) Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) to be presented must be at least equivalent to 25% of the Approved Budget of the Contract

All unamended portions of the Bidding Documents shall remain the same.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents.

Please be informed that the **deadline of submission** and **opening of bids** is on **October 28. 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** and **10:00 a.m.**, respectively.
