- II. The following amendments and clarifications are provided for the prospective bidder(s) guidance and reference:
  - 1. **Reiteration on the delivery dates.** The Department of Tourism (End-User) informs and reiterates that the delivery date is forty five (45) calendar days upon the issuance of the Notice to Proceed (NTP). In the event of a stricter Community Quarantine or restrictions caused by the pandemic, the contract will be adjusted accordingly.
  - 2. **Inspection and Acceptance**. The Inspection and Acceptance of all Software/ Hardware will be ON-SITE. The Inspection and Acceptance of the DOT and the winning bidder will be both present to ensure that all software/hardware are functioning and operational.
  - 3. **Single Largest Contract or SLCC.** As stated in the RA 9184 and its Revised IRR, 23.4.1.3.,"The prospective bidder must have completed, within the period specified in the Invitation to Bid, an SLCC that is similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. However, in the case of Expendable Supplies, said SLCC must be at least twenty five percent (25%) of the ABC." Also, the Bidder's SLCC similar to the Contract to be bid should have been completed within the last three (3) years prior to the deadline and receipt of bids.
  - Gantt Chart. The Gantt chart is attached for the reference and guidance of all prospective / interested bidders.

All unnamed portions of the Bidding Documents and related documents shall remain in effect and the same.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents.
