The Following are the queries/ clarifications asked by the shortlisted bidders during the Pre-Bid Conference and sent thru electronic mail:

- 1. Will the DOT provide a list of possible respondents?
- 2. What is the survey/research sample size, i.e., 180 times 5?
- 3. Will the DOT provide the list of respondents before the submission of bids?
- 4. May we request a copy of the powerpoint presentation.
- 5. Is there a preparatory work done by end-user as the NTDP was mentioned in the TOR.
- 6. Is there a specific study on adventure tourism?
- 7. Can we include other activities such as scuba diving?
- 8. Can we propose our own schedule of deployment?
- Can the listed consultants submitted during Part I (of the Bidding process) be substituted or replaced/add members to the team?
- 10. Do we need to submit hard copies of the report?
- 11. Can we propose a different set of milestones that will be reflected to the proposed methodology?
- 12. Is there any time-stop mechanism?

- Yes. The Project officer/End-User provided relevant data that they have gathered for the research/study.
- 6. To date, the DOT doesn't have an existing study on adventure tourism.
- 7. No. There is a separate team handling dive tourism and they are conducting their own research. Regarding other activities, the inclusion of soft adventure activities (i.e., bird watching, forest bathing) is preferable. But it would be best to focus on the four (4) mentioned activities in the TOR.
- 8. Please refer to the new sets of deliverables.
- As per Section 33.3 of the IRR of the R.A. 9184, "there should no replacement of key personnel before the awarding of contract except for justifiable reasons, as may be determined by the BAC...."
- Yes. The end-user included in the new/revised TOR.
- 11. Please refer to the new schedule of milestones.
- 12. The project should comply to the stated duration in the terms of reference.
