

SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO. 1

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to all prospective bidders to clarify, modify and/or amend items in the Bidding Documents as discussed and agreed during the Pre-Bid Conference held on 17 June 2019 for the Procurement of Security Services for the Department of Tourism (DOT-BAC-IB No. 2019-013).

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents.

I. The following portions of the Bidding Documents are hereby amended as follows:

A. Invitation to Bid

Prospective bidders should have experience in undertaking a similar project within the last five (5) years with an amount of at least 50% of the proposed project for bidding. The eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids shall use non-discretionary "pass / fail" criteria. Post-qualification of the lowest calculated bid shall be conducted.	Prospective bidders should have experience in undertaking a similar project within the last three (3) years with an amount of at least 50% of the proposed project for bidding. The eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids shall use non-discretionary "pass / fail" criteria. Postqualification of the lowest calculated bid shall be conducted.

Item No. 1 (a)(ii) Statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid, within the last three (3) years. Item No. 1 (a)(iii) Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid within the last **three (3)** years. This statement shall be supported with Contract, Certificate of Completion and Certificate of Acceptance (please refer to Annex B)

II. The following are additional clarifications:

- 1. The basis of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is the PADPAO rate. However, for purposes of submitting their bids, the prospective bidders may offer different bid prices below the PADPAO rate without being charged of cut-throat competition or violating the provisions of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 5487, provided that they do not go below the standard salaries and benefits for the guards and the mandated taxes in the minimum cost distribution formula in conformity with existing wage laws. As such, bidders may offer an amount lower than the PADPAO rate by reducing the agency fee covering operational and administrative expenses in computing its bid price.
- 2. The bidders must attach a bid price breakdown, showing the rates per guard, including administrative and operational cost, following the PADPAO format.
- 3. The contract duration is from September to December 2019 (four months).

Please be informed that due to the belated posting of this bid bulletin, the <u>deadline of submission</u> and <u>opening of bids</u> have been moved to <u>July 02, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. and 10:00</u> a.m., respectively.
