



INVITATION TO BID (IB)

The Philippine Department of Tourism (PDOT) is in need of a Tourism Destination Marketing (TDM) company holding an office in **Jakarta, Indonesia**, to act as Marketing Representative who will represent Philippines and its tourism promotions interests in **Indonesia**. The selected company shall undertake the planning, development and implementation of an aggressive and sustained marketing and PR campaign for Philippine tourism.

The PDOT has a budget in the amount of **NINETY-SIX THOUSAND US DOLLARS (US\$96,000.00) or FOUR MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FORTY PHILIPPINE PESOS (PhP4,775,040.00) inclusive of all applicable taxes**. This amount is the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for payment of the development and implementation of a PR and marketing campaign for Philippine Tourism geared towards **Indonesia** market for a period of one (1) year.

The PDOT – Bids and Awards Committee (DOT-BAC) now calls for the submission of bids for the said Project. Interested PR Companies based in **Indonesia** with at least **five (5)** years of existence and with relevant experience in the performance of the deliverables enumerated in the Project's Terms of Reference **must submit their bids in sealed envelopes (stamped received in Manila) on or before 9:00 a.m. of September 26, 2017** through mail or courier (**please indicate name of Project: PDOT TDM for Indonesia**) addressed to the undersigned, c/o Mr. Florencio S. Capati, Jr., PDOT-BAC Secretariat, 4th Floor, DOT Bldg., No. 351, Sen. Gil Puyat Ave., Makati City, Philippines, 1200. **Bids received/stamped in Manila after 9:00 a.m. MANILA TIME of September 26, 2017 shall not be accepted for being late and shall be returned by the PDOT-BAC to the sender/bidder.** Bidders are required to submit one (1) original or certified true copy and six (6) photocopies of their bids. Bidders are advised to please notify through e-mail (pdot.bacsecretariat@gmail.com) the PDOT-BAC the time of mailing its bid to Manila in order to avoid situations of denial of bids in the event that the courier makes a late delivery of an otherwise timely filed/received bids in accordance with this paragraph.


